#### TAKE OVER YOUR ACCOUNT:

Go to CORAL.

Provide your email and ITSF license number, await validation from ITSF or your federation. Upon validation, finalize your account setup via email.


#### NATIONAL TEAMS

**AMATEUR:** Amateur, Rookie, Beginner level based on IFP player list

The ITSF Gold Finals is an annual men's and woman's tournament. held at the end of each season featuring 12 singles players

# HOW TO QUALIFY

WINNER OF THE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP 2022 WINNER OF WORLD SERIES TOP 1 WORLD RANKINGS TOP 1 CONFEDERATION RANKINGS

Substitutions in all cases (except Confederation rankings) will be made from the world rankings.

Substitution for Confederation rankings will be made with the player next in line



### COMPETITION FORMATS



SWISS SYSTEM

All the qualification competitions will be played under the SWISS SYSTEM.

#### **DUALIFICATION**

The swiss system guarantees that at least 50% of players will qualify into the Main Division.

**PAIRING**: In the first round, players are paired randomly. Subsequent rounds pair players based on their current score, with efforts made to pair players with similar scores against each other.

**SCORING**: Players earn points based on the results in the matches.

#### **AVOIDING DUPLICATE PAIRINGS:**

The Swiss system avoids pairing players against each other more than once.

**NUMBER OF ROUNDS**: The tournament continues for 5 rounds, if qualitification time limit is not reach, with players accumulating points after each round.

**TIEBREAKERS** are determined by score, followed by:

- / Buchholz score: This score is the sum of the points of the opponents encountered during the qualification phase. The team with the highest score is ranked higher.
- / Sonneborn-Berger score: This is the sum of the points of defeated opponents only. The team with the highest score is ranked higher.
- Jirect confrontation: The winning team of the direct confrontation, if it took place and if there is a winner, is ranked higher.
- 4 / Highest-ranked opponent: The team that played the highest-ranked opponent is ranked higher. If teams share the highest-ranked opponent, the second highest-ranked opponent is used, etc...
- 5 / Draw (determined by Coral): The team that wins the draw is ranked higher.

# **CLASSIC RULES**

Player figures are not allowed to rotate 360 degrees or more when advancing the ball 10 second time of possession for all rods. Goalie rods are considered one rod. The ball is served and put back into play at the goalie area unless otherwise specified by a rule

Current ITSF passing rules are in effect

#### SEEDING

This year, the Tornado World Series will not have a seeding team. Instead, all American players will have the opportunity to experience the Swiss System. This will involve playing five qualification matches to determine an accurate ranking of teams.

#### **ELIMINATION**

100% of players will qualify for the elimination rounds in every competition

For all official individual categories, the tournament format varies based on the number of participating teams:

**FOR 4 TO B TEAMS:** A Single Knockout (SKO) format is utilized, featuring Best of 3 (Bo3) matches.

**FOR 9 TO 31 TEAM5:** Qualifications are held in a Swiss format with Bo3 matches, followed by the Main Division featuring Bo5 matches.

**FOR 32 TEAMS AND ABOVE:** Qualifications are conducted in a Swiss format with Bo3 matches, followed by the Main Division with Bo5 matches and the Second Division with Bo3 matches.

Qualifying for the Main Division requires winning at least 2 matches.

We ask players to provide exact score to ensure accurate statistical data and to honor the public results that will be accessible in Coral.

#### **DELAYS**

If 9 mins after a game has been called, the game hasn't started and no recall has been made, both teams lose a set even if one team is present at the table. Similarly, they will lose 2 sets after 12 min.

After 15 mins, both teams will be eliminated.

#### EACH PLAYER PLAYS IN ONE ELEMENT

- The 4 players in D1, S1 and S2 are different players
- Each team gets 2 timeouts per match

#### THE MATCH IS A RELAY

- Element 1 (Single 1) plays until one of the two formations has 10 points.
- Element 2 (Single 2) plays until one of the two formations has 20 points.
- Element 3 (Double 1) plays until one of the two formations has 30 points.

#### SUBSTITUTIONS

The team captain may make one substitution per match, which costs one time out

- S1 can be substituted once one formation has reached 5 points
- S2 can be substituted once one formation has reached 15 points
- in D1 one or both of the players can be substituted once one formation has reached 25 points (changing both players in D1 counts as one substitution)

#### REFEREE AND DRESS CODE

#### REFEREE

The tournament fee includes **\$5** for referee fees.

Every referee is required to fill out a form after each match.

Payment will be based on the organizer's referee commission rules and referee fees. Referees receive payment based on their level and number of matches offciated.

This fee does not guarantee a referee for your matches, but limited individual cost.

There is no refereeing during qualification rounds.

During elimination rounds, if no referee is available after 9 minutes, the match must start.

## ANTIDOPING

Even if we're not initiating anti-doping tests at this moment: Play true - commit to sport that is free from doping

The current <u>list of prohibited</u> substances and methods is displayed on WADA's website.



#### DRESS CODE

Players must wear proper sporting attire and are expected to uphold the highest level of personal and professional appearance.

The penalty for violating the dress code: being disqualified for the rest of the day

National team players need to wear the same jersey in the national team categories. Sport Dress is compulsory for ALL players during the competition including ceremonies. (Please refer to ITSF Dress Code HERE for details)
